By Sarah Mensinga


It's Fun and Easy!

Tip #1 - Everyone Belongs has rhyming sentences throughout the story. This style can make it easier for emerging readers to follow a story. It can be a lot of fun to see what rhyming word comes next.

Tip #2 – The illustrations bring the story to life. It features characters of different races, skin tones, abilities, and cultures. It is beautiful to see the world reflected in a book as meaningful as this one.

Tip #3 – The book highlights and values characters with differences and similarities. Discuss with your family or friends what makes you unique.

One of the skills your child must acquire to get ready to read is *print awareness*.




This just means noticing print everywhere, knowing how to



To help your child develop this skill, point out signs as you drive and when you read a book together, identify the title of the book, the author and the illustrator. Occasionally run your finger under the words as you read and let your child turn the pages for you.




